
## CONNECT THE DOTS ACTIVITY

Stovepipe Texas from Map of Texas in 1836

Texas hasn't always looked the way it does today. When the Republic of Texas was formed in 1836, Texians (as they were then called) claimed a much larger territory. The top of Texas, which resembled a stovepipe, even reached as far north as present-day Wyoming!

This outline of Texas was created from *Map* of *Texas in 1836*, a map in the GLO Archives that was created in 1936 to celebrate the **centennial** of Texas independence.
