


## CONNECT THE DOTS ACTIVITY

Alamo Detail from Map of Texas in 1836

Mission San Antonio de Valero – better known as the Alamo – has one of the most iconic and recognizable shapes in the world. The distinctive bell-shaped top (or campanulate, as architects call it) was added as a façade in 1846 by the U.S. Army when they restored the former church.

This outline of the Alamo was created from *Map of Texas in 1836*, a map in the GLO Archives that was created in 1936 to celebrate the **centennial** of Texas independence.
